Please arrive between 8:15-8:30 a.m. at the 23<sup>rd</sup> Street entrance of the State Department that is located between C & D Streets, N.W. about a 12 minute walk from the Foggy Bottom Metro station.

Street parking is not available because of the meters and the State Department cannot allow people to leave to feed their meters. Some parking is available for about \$25 at Columbia Plaza or \$12 at the Kennedy Center (you may have to enter through the A Garage entrance and prior to 9 am to receive the \$12 daily rate).

Metro is the easiest way to arrive at the State Department. There isn't an address for the 23<sup>rd</sup> Street entrance, but you must only use the 23<sup>rd</sup> Street entrance, not the main entrance that is located on C Street.

Every person entering the State Department must go through the security hut located outside the 23<sup>rd</sup> Street entrance and go through airport style security. You present a government issued photo ID to the security officer prior to going through security and again in the lobby of the 23rd Street entrance to obtain a visitor badge from a member of my staff. Once in the State Department participants will only have access to the conference room where the briefings will be held.
