His name is Dave Weber and he will be traveling from California to present.</i></p> <p><i>The session is appropriate to all teachers in the MYP, grades 6-10.</i></p> <p>Dave's bio: <i>David Weber has been a math and science teacher in both Canada and the United States for 30 years. He has been leading MYP math workshops since 2003 and has authored several resources for IBMYP mathematics, including the current mathematics guide and the latest MYP Mathematics 1-3 textbook series for Oxford University Press.</i></p> <p>Expected Session Outcomes: <i>Demystifying the MYP mathematics criteria: With so much time focused on assessments (state, local, MYP, etc.), are the MYP criteria in mathematics an extra burden or a real help? When do we even use each of them? This will be a hands-on session where participants will perform tasks that are aligned with the MYP math</i></p>

criteria and explore the answers to these questions. With a new math guide being introduced in early 2020, participants will also see how changes may affect teaching and learning.

From BWI:

Follow I-195 W to Exit 4B- I-95 S
Take I-95 S to Exit 38B- MD-32 W to Exit 16B- US-29 S/Columbia Pike
Take US-29 S to New Hampshire Ave N
Left on Valley Brook Rd to Springbrook High School

From Dulles:

Get on VA-267 E in Hunter Mill from Aviation Dr
Follow VA-267 E to I-495 N to Exit 30A- US-29 N/Colesville Rd
Continue on US-29 N to your destination in Colesville
Take US-29 S to New Hampshire Ave N
Left on Valley Brook Rd to Springbrook High School

From Reagan:
