

<p>Good Question</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An open-ended question • Explicitly about knowledge • Couched in terms of TOK vocabulary and conceptsⁱ • Precise in terms of relationships between the TOK concepts and the TOK diagram 	
<p>Question to Improve</p>	<p>May be</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An open-ended question • Explicitly about knowledge 	
<p>Weak Question</p>	<p>May be</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A closed question • Implicitly about knowledge 	
<p>Topic (Not a Knowledge Issue) include possible Ways of Knowing and Areas of Knowledge</p>	<p>May be</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A specific statement or description • A subject-specific topic (may be in the form of a question) 	
<p>Real Life Situation</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be a specific real life situation • Newspaper article might be a good specific starting point
