

## **Temporary Primary School English Teacher - Shared** - Washington International School

Reporting to the Primary School Principal, the English teacher is responsible for teaching students how to speak, read, write and understand English in a language-rich, interactive environment, through a push-in and pull-out support model. In addition, the English teacher is responsible for providing small-group support for all students in Grades 3-5.

### *Essential Functions and Responsibilities*

The PS English teacher will:

1. Assess students and conduct ongoing assessment to inform individual instruction.
2. Work with students on oral, written, and listening skills.
3. Plan for individualized and small-group instruction in order to adapt to the curriculum and learning needs of each student.
4. Develop or adapt materials to support students within the classroom and in coordination with the classroom teacher.
5. With the classroom teacher, communicate with parents regarding ongoing progress.
6. Work with students who need support (individuals or small groups) in reading, writing, and/or oral language (with a focus on Grades 3-5).
7. With the English Instructional Support Teacher, identify students who need support through teacher recommendations, classroom observations and assessments.
8. Collaborate and plan with teachers to implement differentiation (including support and enrichment) and to foster best practices and vertical alignment of the curriculum.
9. Assist in administering beginning- and end-of-year assessments in Grades 1-5.
10. Assist with testing accommodations.
11. Participate in Student Support Team meetings for Grades 3-5.

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS (EDUCATION, CERTIFICATION, YEARS EXPERIENCE):**

- Bachelors degree or foreign equivalent; masters degree preferred
- Bilingual *or* proficiency in more than one language
- Minimum three years as a Primary School teacher
- Previous experience in a PYP school and/or trained as a PYP teacher
