



Informal Networking Casual meetups, intended for sharing experiences, challenges, and successes.	Formal Networking Planned events with structured agendas and targeted outcomes, often involving guest
	speakers or roundtable discussions.
- Up to 2 hours	- 3+ hours
- Reimbursement up to \$10 per capita	- Reimbursement up to \$20 per capita
- No honorarium	- \$150 honorarium
